Quinnipiac acrobatics and tumbling went undefeated in the regular season for the first time in program history. The Bobcats clinched the No. 2 seed heading into the NCATA National Tournament in Fairmont, West Virginia. Head coach Mary Ann Powers is amid her 26th season with the acrobatics and tumbling team, consistently competing on a nationally ranked level. Last season, Quinnipiac came just shy of a national championship appearance, falling 281.055-272.420 to No. 1 Baylor in the NCATA semifinals.

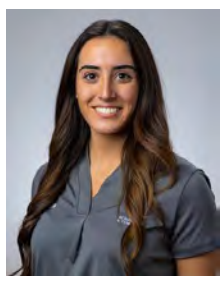
